The Alberta Green Party CFO resigned only a few days before Christmas. We retained a lawyer to assist us with the transition of leadership, and to also assist us in meeting our regulatory requirements. We knew at that time there were significant problems. We also retained the accounting firm Myers Norris Penny, and had them review the financial information that was given to the new leadership. MNP issued what is called an unaudited statement, which we immediately disclosed to Elections Alberta. In short the unaudited statement simple states that there is not enough information available to file an audited statement.

We immediately set up a meeting with elections Alberta, and in good faith disclosed everything we discovered. We have had numerous contacts with Elections Alberta since that meeting and very little about our financial status has changed since.

The financial problems with the Green Party are significant and they go far deeper than just failing to file a year-end financial statement. How much George Read knew about the financial records or lack thereof, I really don't know. I tend to believe he is innocent.
