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>>Since the September 27, 2008 efforts have been underway to recover the

>>necessary information to reconcile the Alberta Green Party's membership

>>records and financial records. In this regard we are, and have been,

>>working transparently with Elections Alberta.

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>>To assist us in this endeavour we have retained the services of Myers Norris

>>Penny (MNP), Chartered Accountants, and Mr. Luke Karata, legal counsel, to

>>act in the Party's interests with respect to its status with Elections

>>Alberta, its continued registration as a political party in accordance with

>>the Elections Finances and Contributions Disclosures Act, (the Act,) and the

>>interests of contributors in the preparation and issuance of Official

>>Receipts.

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>>At this time we are unable to issue tax receipts due to the lack of

>>information, in the form of records and documents, necessary to account for

>>donations to the party. On a more positive note, we have submitted a request

>>to Elections Alberta for permission to issue tax receipts based on

>>unverifiable information in our possession. If and when more information

>>becomes available in the future, we will update the membership.
